RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2023 POWER CONTENT LABEL

WHEREAS, the Power Source Disclosure Program was established in 1997 under SB 1305 to provide “accurate, reliable and simple-to-understand information on the sources of energy that are used to provide electric services” to California consumers; and

WHEREAS, the Eastside Power Authority (“ESPA”) procures electricity for its members and has filed annually a Power Source Disclosure with the California Energy Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Power Source Disclosure reports provides the information for the Power Content Label; and

WHEREAS, The California Energy Commission (CEC) has requested that the Power Content Label be provided to the utility’s customers served by each electricity portfolio and to the CEC on or before the end of the first complete billing cycle for the third quarter of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Eastside Power Authority (Board) hereby:

1. Determines that the data for ESPA’s 2023 Power Content Label that is attached hereto as Attachment A, is true and correct.
2. Authorizes this resolution to take effect immediately upon its adoption.
